Distributor Channel Considerations

As of July 1, 2006, All product shipped by Tableau to distributors and resellers located in the EU is strictly RoHS Compliant.

Tableau distributors and resellers may have stock of older Tableau inventory which does not match the RoHS Compliance status as listed in the above table. Prior to July 1, 2006, Tableau began working with its EU-based resellers to reduce or eliminate stocks of Tableau product which is not RoHS Compliant. However, it is beyond Tableau's control to ensure that no non-compliant stock remains in the hands of its EU-based resellers.

Tableau also works with its resellers based outside of the EU to ensure that those Tableau resellers who export to the EU have stock of RoHS Compliant Tableau product.

¹ EU Directive 2002/95/EC as amended by EU Commission Decision 2005/618/EC sets limits on the allowable concentrations of six substances: Cadmium (Cd), Lead (Pb), Mercury (Hg), Hexavalent Chromium (Cr₆₊), Poly Brominated Byphenyls (PBB), and Poly Brominated Diphenyl Ethers (PBDE).
