

Tableau JavaScript API Hackathon- Official Rules

THE FOLLOWING CONTEST IS OPEN TO ALL LEGAL RESIDENTS OF THE UNITED STATES, CANADA, MEXICO, UK, GERMANY, FRANCE, AND JAPAN. DO NOT ENTER THIS CONTEST IF YOU ARE NOT A RESIDENT OF THESE COUNTRIES, OR IF YOU ARE OTHERWISE PROHIBITED BY LOCAL LAW TO PARTICIPATE IN THE SAME.

PARTICIPATION IN THIS CONTEST CONSTITUTES YOUR ACCEPTANCE OF THESE OFFICIAL RULES.

1. Contest Description: VOID WHERE PROHIBITED BY LAW. The Tableau JavaScript API Hackathon contest (“Contest”) is a skill contest in which someone can submit a Tableau JavaScript API.

2. Term: The Contest begins on August 4th at 12:01 a.m. Eastern Daylight Time (“EDT”) and ends on August 14th at or around 8:00 p.m. EDT (the “Term”). Contest entry submissions open on August 4th at 12:01 a.m. EDT and end at 11:59 p.m. EDT (the “Submission Period”). The following table lists all relevant deadlines and Contest milestones:

3. Eligibility: To be eligible to enter the Contest, at the time of entry, you must: (i) have validly registered as a contestant in this Contest at <https://www.tableau.com/JavaScript-API-hackathon> (ii) be a legal resident of the United States, Canada, Mexico, UK, Germany, France, or Japan; and (iii) be above the legal age of majority in the jurisdiction where you reside; (“Entrant”). Employees and representatives of Tableau Software, its respective parents, agents, subsidiaries, advertising and promotional agencies, any prize provider, and any entity involved in the development, production, implementation, administration or fulfillment of the Contest, and their immediate family members (defined as parents, children, siblings, spouse, or life partner) and persons living in the same household, are not eligible to participate. Tableau reserves the right to verify eligibility and to adjudicate on any dispute at any time.

4. How to Enter: To enter the Contest, visit <https://www.tableau.com/JavaScript-API-hackathon> the “Site” during the Term, register as a contestant, create a JavaScript API project, create a video of your project, and host it on YouTube or Vimeo. You agree to provide the Submission and authorize Tableau to make public, and make it publically accessible and available at all times during the Term. All Submissions must comply with all Tableau terms and conditions of use, available at <http://www.tableausoftware.com/tos>.

Submissions entered into the Contest may not be acknowledged. Proof of entry does not constitute proof of receipt by Tableau. Submissions must be received by Tableau no later than the end of the Submission Period. Only eligible Submissions actually received by Tableau during the Submission Period will be eligible to win. Sponsor is not responsible for (i) inaccessible, lost, late, misdirected, mutilated, damaged, irregular, altered, counterfeit, fraudulent, incomplete, or illegible Submissions, which are void, or (ii) for any computer-related, online, telephonic, or technical malfunctions that may occur. Illegible, unintelligible, inaccessible, non-public, incomplete, garbled, or mutilated Submissions will be disqualified. Tableau reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify any Submissions not in compliance with these Official Rules.

By making a Submission and participating in the Contest, you represent and warrant that: (i) you agree to the terms and conditions of use of the www.tableausoftware.com website available at <http://www.tableausoftware.com/tos>, and also hereby grant Tableau an irrevocable, royalty-free license to use your Submission for marketing and promotional use; (ii) you are the owner of the Submission, the Submission is your original work, and you have secured any and all rights, releases, or permissions necessary for

the use and distribution of your Submission by Tableau; (iii) your Submission does not violate or infringe upon the copyright, trademark, or other intellectual property rights, publicity rights, or any other rights of any third party; (iv) your Submission does not contain data that should remain confidential or private.

5. How to Win: One (1) winner will be selected for the Main Prize and two (2) winners will be selected for the Runners-Up Prizes (as defined below).

A panel of judges, comprised of Tableau employees (“Panel”) will evaluate all submissions based on the following criteria:

50% - Potential Impact

50% - Visual Appeal/Design

The Panel will evaluate all Submissions and name a group of Finalists. Finalists will be announced and the community will vote to select the winner and two runners-up.

On August 24, the winners will be announced, notified by email and announced in publicly available forums, events and media as determined, selected and represented by Tableau. If a winner does not respond to the notification attempt within three (3) days from the first notification attempt, then such potential winner will be disqualified and an alternate winner will be selected from among the remaining contestants based on the judging criteria described herein.

The judges' decisions are final with respect to all aspects of the Contest. Tableau and its parent, affiliates, subsidiaries, employees, agents, officers and directors, advertising and Contest agencies, and their respective officers, directors, employees and their respective agents will not be liable for unsuccessful efforts to notify a winner. If a potential winner declines a prize, fails to claim a prize, cannot be contacted within the time period stated herein, fails to abide by the Official Rules, is determined to be ineligible, or if a prize notification email is returned as undeliverable, such prize will be forfeited, and Tableau may select an alternate potential winner from all remaining eligible entries as described herein.

6. Prizes:

The Main Prize will be awarded to one winner. The Main Prize includes: (a) one conference registration to the 2017 Tableau Customer Conference in Las Vegas, Nevada (currently scheduled for October 9-12, 2017), (b) a Tableau Swag Bag (“Main Prize”). Approximate value: \$1695.

The Runners-Up Prize will be awarded to two winners. The Runners-Up Prize is a Tableau Swag Bag (“Runners-Up Prize”). Approximate value: \$100.

No prize substitution, cash substitution, or assignment or transfer of any of the prizes is permitted, except by Tableau for reason of unavailability. The prize consists of only those items specifically listed as part of the prize. All taxes, costs, and fees associated with the Prize are the sole responsibility of the winners. LIMIT ONE PRIZE PER PERSON. Odds of winning depend on the number of entries and the skill of the entrants.

7. Conduct: By participating in the Contest, Entrants agree to comply with and be bound by these Official Rules. Failure to comply with these Official Rules may result in disqualification from the Contest. Entrants further agree to comply with and be bound by decisions of Tableau, which shall be final and binding in all respects. Tableau reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify any individual it finds to be: (a) tampering or attempting to tamper with the operation of the Contest or Tableau’s web site(s); (b) violating these Official Rules; (c) violating the terms of service, conditions of use and/or general rules or guidelines of any Tableau property or services; or (d)

acting in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner, or with intent to annoy, abuse, threaten or harass any other person.
