

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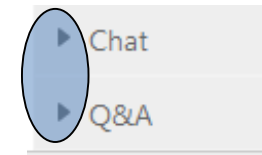
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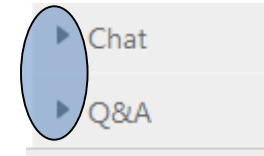

About Utah State University

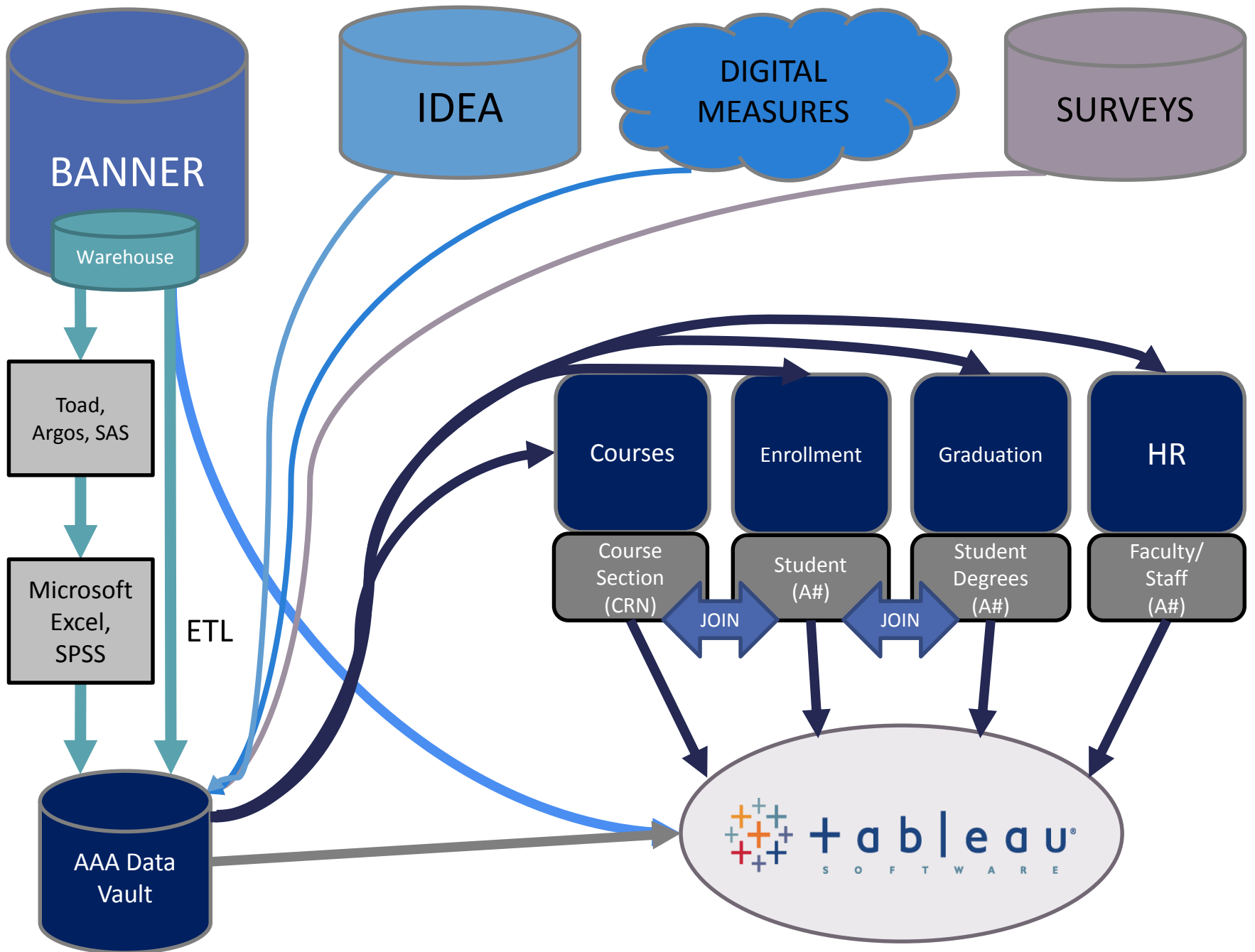
- Founded March 8, 1888

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

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
